

Are Any Bathroom Faucets Leaking?

- A leaky faucet can waste from 6 to 100 gallons of water per day.
- For suggestions on how to fix leaks, you can request the California Urban Water Conservation Council's publication, "Practical Plumbing Handbook", by calling (800) 544-4498 and then pressing "0".
- If you provide your name and address, LADWP will send you a free copy.

Bathroom Faucets



Bathroom Faucet Aerator

- The aerator is a device at the end of your faucet's spout which decreases the flow through your faucet by adding air to the water.
- You can check your current aerator gallons per minute usage by looking at the side of the aerator.

Normally, your bathroom faucet aerator will be rated for 2.2 gpm like the one pictured below.

- If your bathroom faucet aerator is rated at 2.2 gpm, you can receive free 1.5 gpm or 1.0 gpm aerators from the LADWP.

Is The Kitchen Faucet Leaking?

- Repairing a leaking kitchen faucet is more challenging than a bathroom faucet.

Toilets



High Efficiency Toilets (HET)

- The Department's Ultra-Low-Flush Toilet (1.6 gallons/flush) programs ended in 2006.
- HET toilets are rated at 1.28 gpf (gallons per flush). Your non-HET toilet may be using 3.5 gpf or more.



 There may be a rebate for the installation of a HET. Please visit <u>www.ladwp.com</u> to check for the current rebate list.

Toilet Leaks

- Check for toilet leaks by adding a few drops of food coloring to the water in the tank.
- If you don't have food coloring then the LADWP can supply dye tablets like these pictured. Call (800) 544-4498 press "0".
- After adding the food coloring or dye tablets wait a few
 - minutes, and see if any dye enters the bowl. If it does, then you have a leak.
- Repair the leak by consulting the "Practical Plumbing Handbook".







High Efficiency Clothes Washer Rebate

- High Efficiency Clothes Washers can save you up to 30 gallons per wash load.
- Rebates are only available for washers that are on the qualifying list.

Landscape Watering





Watering Tips

- Only water in the early morning
- Find out how long it takes for water run-off to enter the sidewalk or driveway.
- Segment the total watering time into equal parts to prevent run-off.

Landscape Watering





Watering Tips

- Example On How To Prevent Run-off:
 - Lawn needs 6 minutes of watering 3 days/week
 - Run-off occurs after 2 minutes of watering.
 - Break the watering time into three (3), 2minute segments.

Landscape Watering





Watering Tips

- Example On How To Prevent Run-off (continued):
 - Set the timer to come on at 4 am, 5 am, and 6 am for 2 minutes each time.
 - This will allow sufficient soak time for the plants and should lead to less run-off.

Landscape Watering



Weather-Based Irrigation Controllers

- Sophisticated or "smart" weather-based irrigation controllers are available in the marketplace today.
- These controllers automatically adjust watering times each and every day according to the weather.
- Normally, watering times are only adjusted in the winter and summer.
- By changing watering times on a daily basis, significant water can be saved.
