Balboa Blvd Earthquake Resistant Pipeline Replacement Project

Project Description

As part of LADWP's Water Infrastructure Improvement Program this Project is being divided into three phases,



Project Schedule February 2018 -February 2019 Region Encino which will replace approximately one mile of 12inch water mainline installed in 1932 with earthquake resistant ductile iron pipe.

This project is part of LADWP's plan to install 10 miles of earthquake resistant pipe in areas of the City affected by seismic activity.

Construction Information

Phase I is scheduled to begin Feb. 26 and be completed in late July. Construction for Phase II is scheduled for July-October and Phase III for October-February of 2019.


One lane will be available to north and south bound traffic in construction zones. Temporary tow-away/no parking signs will be posted as needed. Driveway and local access will be provided.

Hours of work are Mon.-Fri. 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Sat. 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. There will be occasional evening work Mon.-Fri. until 9 p.m. There will also be occasional overnight work on Sat. from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Evening construction will take place during Phase I near the 101 Ventura Freeway on ramps on Balboa Blvd. and during Phase III at the intersection of Balboa Blvd. and Ventura Blvd.



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
