Scattergood to West LA - Sawtelle Modernization

Construction Notice

From November 2021, through March 2023, 7 am – 7 pm Monday through Saturday, LADWP will remove old and install new underground transmission cables to provide reliable power to the community, increase capacity, reduce long-term maintenance and replacement costs and increase flexibility to the electric system. The southernmost work starts at Scattergood Generating Station with underground work taking place intermittently at maintenance holes along Vista Del Mar, north of Grand Ave, onto Westchester Pkwy to Loyola Blvd to Lincoln Blvd to Culver Blvd to Centinela Ave/Bundy Drive, connecting to Receiving Station K. Underground cable will be removed on Pershing Dr from Imperial Hwy onto Culver Dr to Centinela Ave (see map on back for details).

Work trucks will be parked over maintenance holes to protect employees and traffic. No work will be performed on some holidays. After each work day, traffic lanes will be restored and reopened.

Traffic and parking may be partially impacted along these streets. Flaggers will assist traffic in some areas. Access to businesses will remain open. Alternate routes and extra travel time recommended.
