Airport Police Recycled Water Pipeline Project

Project Description


The Los Angeles
Department of Water and
Power (LADWP) will install a
new pipe along 91st Street,
between Stanmoor Drive
and Loyola Boulevard, and
along Loyola Boulevard from
91st Street to approximate
300' south of La Tijera
Boulevard. LADWP will
install 3,400 linear feet of 6inch diameter pipe that will
transport high-quality

recycled water from Hyperion Water Treatment Facility to Los Angeles International Airport Police facility.

Construction Information

Construction will begin in January 2021 and is scheduled to be completed by June 2021. Typical work hours will be from 8:00AM to 4:00PM. There may be occasional work on Saturday.

Construction will require a full road closure of 91st Street during Phase 1 and 2. Access to driveways will be impacted as construction progresses. Crews will notify and coordinate with residents to assist with access through the construction zone. Please allow extra time to navigate through construction. Local access will be allowed only to residents located directly in front of construction activities. Excavated areas will be securely covered by steel plates during non-construction times.
