

Sepulveda-Venice Water Pipeline Connection

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is continuing construction on the installation of an emergency connection to the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) of Southern California's water supply.

Construction Information

Construction began in September 2018 and is scheduled to be completed by late 2020. To reduce the impact to the community, construction of the project is divided into multiple stages. The first three stages of construction have been completed.

Construction on Stage 4 will begin in late January. Working hours will be Monday through Friday, 8am to no later than 7pm, and Saturday work may be required.

Traffic impacts during Stage 4 include:

- Two lanes of eastbound traffic on Venice Blvd. will be open.
- Westbound traffic on Venice Blvd. between Veteran Ave. and Bentley Ave. may be reduced to two lanes from 9am – 3pm.
- Three lanes of westbound traffic on Venice Blvd. will be open at all other times.
- Traffic lanes will be restriped on Venice Blvd and parking will be restricted during construction.
- Temporary No Parking/Tow-Away signs will be posted as needed.

SPECIAL TRAFFIC CONDITION

For approximately 3 weeks beginning January 27, no turns will be allowed onto eastbound Venice Blvd from Sepulveda Blvd, and Venice Blvd. will be reduced to one lane between 9am – 3pm.
