

# Cancellation of Unsafe Water Alert

## **CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE FOR THE AREA BOUNDED BY SOUTH ARDMORE AVENUE ON THE WEST, SOUTH MARIPOSA AVENUE ON THE EAST, WEST 5TH STREET ON THE NORTH AND WEST 6TH STREET ON THE SOUTH**

This notice is to inform you that your water is now safe for drinking (including baby formula), bathing, hand washing, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation. It is **NO LONGER NECESSARY** to boil your tap water or to continue using bottled water. On July 1, 2026 you were notified of the need to boil all tap water used for drinking and cooking purposes due to the detection of Escherichia coli (E. coli) bacteria in a sample collected in this area.

Based on water quality testing, LADWP has concluded, with the concurrence of the California State Water Resources Control Board's Division of Drinking Water, that the tap water in all areas impacted by the July 1, 2026 Alert is now safe for all uses.

Please share this information with all other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this public notice directly such as people in apartments, nursing homes, schools and businesses. You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

LADWP continues to regularly conduct comprehensive tests on the water in order to ensure it meets state and federal water quality standards. We thank you for your patience.
