Qualifications

Qualifying water conservation measures include equipment, devices, products, fixtures, and technologies that are installed to reduce your water use. Leased equipment and performance-based measures are now eligible.

Details

The incentive amount is based on the water savings accomplished by the project. The incentive is calculated at \$7.00 per 1,000 gallons of water saved over a number of years depending on the project; not to exceed the installed cost of the project. Incentives are paid upon verified installation and operation of pre-approved projects.

Rebate Application Process

1. Customers send application and supporting documents to WCTAP@ladwp.com.
2. LADWP reviews application and conducts a pre-inspection.
3. LADWP sends a pre-approval letter and makes a preliminary estimate of savings and rebates.
4. Customers install and operate equipment as proposed on the application.
5. Customer submits invoices, receipts, final meter readings, and any additional documentation before post-inspection is scheduled.
6. LADWP inspects the completed project and makes the final determination of cost and water savings estimates and issues the rebate.
