CEQA Process and Schedule

The purpose of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is to inform the public and decision makers about potential significant impacts of a project, and ways impacts can be mitigated or avoided, before the project is considered for approval

- The City of Los Angeles is the CEQA lead agency represented by the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) and Los Angeles Sanitation and Environment (LASAN) as joint partners

The Notice of Preparation (NOP) notifies interested parties that the City is preparing a Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) to evaluate environmental impacts of the Program

- Subsequent Project-level CEQA will be conducted as needed as designs are finalized and individual components are considered for approval
- The purpose of this NOP scoping period is to obtain input from the public and agencies on the environmental issues to be evaluated in the PEIR
