Silver Lake Reservoir Complex Maintenance

Conducted by LADWP Personnel

- Dam and spillway safety monitoring
- Regulator station maintenance

- Landscaping, weed abatement, general facility upkeep
- Water quality sampling (regularly scheduled) and treatment (asneeded)
- 24/7 Security

Aeration and Recirculation Systems Project Objectives

Install aeration and recirculation systems to properly mix and de-stratify the reservoir water





Project Status

Aeration System


- Design was completed in May 2018
- Construction is anticipated to start in winter 2020 by inhouse construction forces

Recirculation System

- Design started in October 2018, it is 30% complete
- Construction will follow the aeration project also by in-house forces
- Anticipate both systems will be operational by Spring 2022




Silver Lake Reservoir Complex






Modular Office Site Plan











Stormwater Capture Project
