



### **Background**

- Reservoirs were taken out of the water system service
  - Silver Lake in 2013 and Ivanhoe in 2017
- In April 2017, reservoirs were refilled with surplus water from the Eastern Sierra
- To maintain the water level in the Reservoirs, groundwater from Pollock Wells is used
- Water Quality Testing



# **Project Objectives**



- Control algal growth and associated odors at Reservoirs
- Install aeration and recirculation system to properly mix the water body





### **Project Status**

#### **Aeration System**

- Design was completed in May 2018
- Construction started May 10, 2021 by our in-house construction crews

#### **Recirculation System**


- Design started in October 2018 and was completed December 2020
- Construction will follow the Aeration project also by in-house crews

Both systems to be operational by Summer 2023




# Silver Lake Reservoir Complex

#### Construction

- Aeration and Recirculation Timing
- Ivanhoe Reservoir WILL be drained into Silver Lake Reservoir
  - Drained Spring 2022
  - Refilled Spring 2023
- Silver Lake WILL NOT be drained



#### Construction

- Construction vehicles
  - Backhoes and trucks
- Noise reduction measures will be implemented
- Traffic impacts are not anticipated
  - All work within complex
- Work hours
  - 7am to 3:30pm, Monday thru Friday
