Fix Leaks

Checking for leaks in faucets, plumbing joints and your sprinkler system and repairing them can save 20 gallons a day for every leak stopped.

Shut Off

Locate, mark, and periodically operate your water shut off valves so they are easily identified in case of a pipe break or leak.

Let the Rain Do Your Watering

Remember outdoor watering is prohibited when it is raining. Redirect water from downspouts and channel storm water across your lawn and into your garden.

Adjust Your Sprinklers

Direct sprinklers so that they water your lawn or garden. and not the sidewalk.

Shorten Your Showers

A one- or two-minute reduction can save up to 375 gallons per month.
