

# WATER SAVINGS

## Fix Leaks

Checking for leaks in faucets, plumbing joints and your sprinkler system and repairing them can save 20 gallons a day for every leak stopped.

## Shut Off

Locate, mark, and periodically operate your water shut off valves so they are easily identified in case of a pipe break or leak.

## Let the Rain Do Your Watering

Remember outdoor watering is prohibited when it is raining. Redirect water from downspouts and channel storm water across your lawn and into your garden.

## Adjust Your Sprinklers

Direct sprinklers so that they water your lawn or garden, and not the sidewalk.

## Shorten Your Showers

A one- or two-minute reduction can save up to 375 gallons per month.
